## 5 Year Plan

Raise \$500,000 for three goals: scholarships, educational programs, and forestry economic development

Scholarships would be immediately available for Hurricane Katrina victims and long term for qualifying students

The educational funding would be available to Project Learning Tree, Teacher's Conservation Workshops, and public policymakers

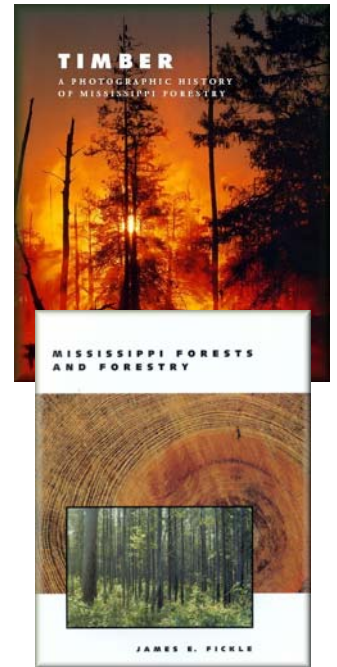
The Mississippi Institute for Forest Inventory would be supplemented through the forestry economic development goal

The Mississippi Forestry Foundation is a nonprofit corporation established in 1964 by the Mississippi Forestry Association to promote and carry out educational, literary, scientific, and charitable programs to better conserve, develop, and protect the forest and related natural resources of Mississippi for the best interest of this and future generations.

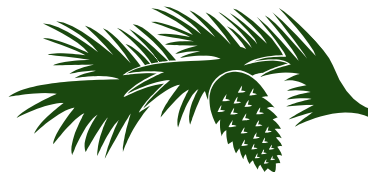

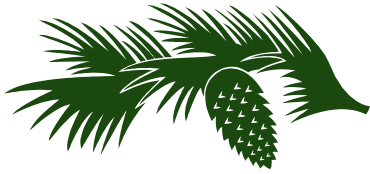
