What is “TCW”?

The Teachers Conservation Workshop, which we affectionately call “TCW” is a practical, hands-on conservation workshop with emphasis on forests and other natural resources. The latest information on conservation is presented in the classroom and in numerous field trips including industries, harvesting operations, management practices, and nature trails. Participants learn by demonstration and practical exercises how relevant conservation practices can be integrated into classroom work and student projects.

Instructors include professionals from Mississippi State University, Mississippi Forestry Commission, Natural Resource Conservation Service, USDI Bureau of Land Management, MS Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks, U.S. Forest Service, forest industries, consulting foresters and many other natural resource organizations and companies. Participants will be certified to use teaching materials of the nationally acclaimed, award-winning environmental education curriculum Project Learning Tree.

This is a highly active workshop. Come prepared for forestry field trips, nature walks, and wading in streams. In addition to the scheduled activities, participants enjoy networking with other educators. Scheduled activities start early and end late. Participants must attend all scheduled sessions to receive academic credit or CEU’s.

Who is Eligible?

Teachers, school administrators, youth educators, undergraduates, and others may apply. Due to limited space, only forty participants will be enrolled in each session. Consideration will be given to teaching duties, subject assignments, the number of times applicant has already attended TCW, as well as the date applications are submitted. Participants may repeat the workshop every five years.

Registration / Enrollment

A registration fee of \$100 is required. Fee includes all meals and lodging, an official TCW shirt, and all course materials. The fee is not refunded for cancellations after May 28th for the South Workshop and June 4th for the North Workshop. Register early! Class size is limited. Your registration will be confirmed immediately by e-mail.

Sponsorships

A limited number of registration fee (\$100) sponsorships may be available from local organizations. Contact the local county offices of the Mississippi State University Extension Service or Mississippi Forestry Commission to find out if the local County Forestry Association (CFA) is offering sponsorships for teachers. Contact your local office of the USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service to find out if your local Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD) is offering sponsorships.

Accommodations

Meals and lodging are provided by MFA. Participants are housed in semi-private dormitory rooms, with most meals served in the dining facilities at each location. A letter including a detailed schedule and a list of “items to bring” will be sent to all registrants. Clothes for hiking, wading, industry tours and the classroom will be needed.

Continuing Education Units (CEUs)

The Teachers Conservation Workshop qualifies for 4.0 CEUs. Completion of a final examination and lesson plan provides an opportunity for one additional CEU. Registration for CEUs will be completed after you arrive at the workshop. The fee will be no more than \$15.00 and will be collected during the workshop.

Academic Credit & Tuition

Teachers Conservation Workshop may be used for graduate and undergraduate programs in education upon approval of advisors. Academic credit is available through the Continuing Education offices of our three major universities.
